- Data entry (paper and electronic) as necessary for work documentation
- Attend mandatory training to obtain TCEQ certification

- Assist in recording pertinent data required by state, city and department
- Respond to service calls as needed
- Assist in training personnel on various machinery operations
- Keep all work areas, building and equipment clean and organized
- Keen ability to follow directions, show initiative and work well with a team
- Regular and timely attendance
- Perform other essential duties as required to achieve successful operations of the department

Qualifications

- Highschool diploma or equivalent
- Valid TX driver's license rated class "A" CDL with insurable record or must obtain one within twelve (12) months of employment
- Must obtain class "D" water distribution license and class "I" collection license within twelve (12) months from date of employment
- The position does not require prior experience, and on the job training will be provided as necessary

Working Conditions

- Full-time position with hourly pay
- Standard 40-hour workweek Monday through Friday
- Reading and comprehending oral and written instructions, operations and safety manuals, signs, maps, memos, and blueprints
- Performing mathematical calculations as needed with regards to equipment readings, volume, and capacity
- While performing the duties of this job, the employee is frequently required to lift, carry, and position objects weighing up to 75 pounds and occasionally up to 100 pounds
- While performing this job, the employee may be exposed to exhaust and fumes, toxic or caustic chemicals, moving mechanical parts, and outside weather conditions
