Have Summer fun... Safely!

Summer means fun in the sun, water, or on the open road! No matter how you're celebrating summer, make sure you're staying safe and saving water!

Travel Tips:

- Avoid driving, parking, or idling on dry grass
- Check local burn bans, water use restrictions, and fireworks regulations
- Secure tow chains before traveling so they do not drag
- Don't leave campfires unattended
- Never leave pets or children unattended in a vehicle: LOOK before you LOCK

Grilling Safety:

- Only use grills outside, and be sure to maintain a 3' safe zone between a hot grill and buildings, siding, eaves, and railings
- Never walk away from a lit grill or leave grills unattended when in use
- Be sure to clean grills after each use to avoid grease fires
- Dispose of cool, used coals in a metal can with a lid

Outdoor Fun:

- Know the signs of heat stroke and heat exhaustion
- Stay hydrated, drink plenty of water, even if you don't feel thirsty
- Wear loose-fitting and light-colored clothing
- Avoid midday heat, spend time in the shade or air conditioned spaces to rest

THE FOLLOWING USES OF WATER ARE NONESSENTIAL AND SHOULD BE REDUCED WHERE POSSIBLE:

- WASHING DOWN SIDEWALKS, DRIVEWAYS, PARKING LOTS
- WASHING DOWN BUILDINGS OR STRUCTURES FOR PURPOSES OTHER THAN FIRE PROTECTION
- FLUSHING GUTTERS OR PERMITTING WATER TO RUN OR ACCUMULATE IN GUTTERS OR STREETS
- FAILING TO REPAIR A CONTROLLABLE LEAK WITHIN A REASONABLE TIME PERIOD
